MODE OF SELECTION


i	Written Test- Objective type Test (MCQs) for 50 marks (<u>one mark each</u>) in the respective subjects for one and half hour (1 ½ hr.) Candidates scoring 50% & above (Gen) and 45% & above (SC/ST/OBC/PH) will be considered for Skill test. (All question papers will be in English medium) – No negative marking
ii	Skill Test – For the candidates short-listed on the basis of written test. It will be by Go/No Go method.
iii	Those who have been declared as "GO" in the Skill Test would be empanelled in the order of merit based on the marks scored in the written examination. The selected candidates will be empanelled and the panel will be operated as and when vacancies arise in AEC Schools, Rawatbhata
iv	Retired teachers from AEES/ KVS/NVS and State Government schools may be given an option to appear for written test or forego the same and in case they forego the written test, they may be allowed to appear for only skill test; Retired teachers who wish to appear for written test and skill test for contract teacher service and if they qualify in both they shall be empanelled in the order of merit based on the marks scored in written examination; If such retired teachers opt only to appear for skill test and if they are declared as "GO" in the skill test, their names can be included at the end of the panel, with due consideration being given for seniority in respect to age.
v	The Result of the written test will be displayed on school notice board of AECS-4, Rawatbhata on same day.

(E) General Information for all candidates :

i)	Competency to teach the concerned subjects through English medium is essential. Knowledge of computer applications & Proficiency in Hindi are desirable.
ii)	Candidates must apply separately for each post (if applying for more than one post) alongwith photographs & photocopies of testimonials & submit the same at the time of registration on the day of walk-in-written test-cum- skill test.
iii)	The SC/ST/OBC/PH candidates should submit a self attested copy of their Caste Certificate with the application.
iv)	No TA/DA will be paid for attending the written test and skill test.
v)	Candidates must bring the original certificates at the time of the skill test.
vi)	Candidates are required to report at the exam venue strictly as per the time mentioned in the circular/advertisement.
vii)	Applications with insufficient details, copies of certificates etc. will be summarily rejected.
viii)	The candidates should note that their admission to the Written Test and Skill Test will be purely provisional, based on the information given by them in the online form. This will be subject to verification of all the eligibility conditions with reference to original documents as specified in the Recruitment notice. Candidature of an applicant is liable to be rejected at any stage of recruitment process or even after joining, if any information provided by the candidate during the entire process of recruitment/selection is found to be false or not in conformity with the eligibility criteria at any stage.
ix)	Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidate.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. They will be permitted to carry only the following items with them to the venue :
 - a) Personal transparent water bottle (Candidate should bring his / her own water bottle)
 - b) Personal hand sanitizer (50 ml.)
 - c) A blue ball point pen
 - d) Exam related documents – Originals & Photocopy of Qualifications and Experiences, if any.
 - e) No other items are permitted inside the venue.
2. Candidates should not share any of their personal belongings/material with anyone.
3. Candidates should maintain safe social distance with one another.
4. Candidates should stand in the row as per the instruction provided at venue.
